## MATH

Read your favorite book at home. Draw a picture of the setting and its characters! Don't forget to add detail.

Let's celebrate today! Create your own holiday. Copy and finish the sentences:

Choose 3 items at home and put them in order from lightest to heaviest. Draw a picture of them in order and label what they are.

Read and practice your sight word lists for ten minutes! Take a picture of you practicing, and send it to your teacher on Class Dojo!

Write three sentences about what you have done today. Be sure to use transitional words like: first, then, and next!

Practice writing your numbers from 0-30. Circle all of the tens!

Choose a story to read to your parents! Use the pictures to help tell the story. Ask your parent to draw a picture of the main character. Help them write a sentence about the character.

Draw a picture of the weather outside. Use what you know about the physical properties of matter (color, size, temperature, solid, liquid, gas, etc...) to write two sentences about your picture.

Watch the read aloud of [Clark the Shark](#). Draw and label a picture of the main character, the problem, and the solution!

Draw a picture of a shark that includes 5 labels. Use those labels to write 3 complete informational sentences. Don't forget to capitalize, punctuate, use finger space and correct letter formation.

Use cereal to model the following addition problems.

3+4= 7+3= 5+5= 3+8= 6+4=  
3+5= 2+1= 4+4= 3+2= 8+2=  
1+6= 3+1= 8+1= 1+9= 5+3=

Practice reading the following CVC words: mad, can, cap, bit, kit, rob, not, cub, hug, & pet. Turn the following words into CVCE words (ex. man-mane). Have students illustrate a picture of each CVCE word they created.

We've learned about rocks already! Go outside (if weather permits) and find 5 rocks. After you wash them, sort them by color, then order them by size. Choose one to be a pet rock and read it a story!

Practice making tally marks by counting the number of spoons, butter knives, forks in your utensil draw. Compare the sets and determine which are, more, less or equal.

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## READING

Practice finding rhyming pairs around the house! (Ex: sock and lock) Try to find and list five pairs.

Watch [Alexander and the Terrible, Horrible, No Good, Very Bad Day](#) read aloud. Compare Alexander and yourself. How are you alike and different.
