# Math Choice Board

Count groups of objects found in the house and label with the correct number.

Ex. 3 socks, count the number and label.

Have your child put a deck of cards (just the numbers) in order from least to greatest OR greatest to least.

Line up household items from tallest to shortest then reverse it!

Use sidewalk chalk to make circles with numbers. Have your child place the correct number of objects (rocks, sticks, toys..) in the circle to represent the number.

Use a board game to practice counting. Have your child roll the dice and move their piece the correct number of spaces.

Have your child give you a number of objects that you request. (Ex. Say, "Give 3 cheerios." "Give 5 pennies.)

Roll and count the number on dice. Add more dice to make greater numbers to count.

Have your child sort a deck of cards. Be sure to talk about the numbers as they work.

Have your child write or copy numbers. (1-10) (11-20) Make it fun use chalk, paint, water...
